



Regional Outreach Committee:

Purpose: Aimed at creating a sense of belonging across Québec, the Regional Outreach Committee develops Y4Y's Local Youth Committees (LYC), in tandem with the Community Liaisons and Youth Cultural Ambassadors. The Committee collaborates with other youth organisations, coordinates LYC activities, and meets with community members across the province.

Sample of Committee tasks for 2024–25:

- Create an outreach plan to attract at least 6 new members to the Committee, representing various regions of Québec
- Develop & publish a new tab on Y4Y's website, entitled "Join the Regional Outreach Committee"
- Encourage participation of Committee members in all Y4Y Community events (virtual and in-person)
- Hold a brain-storming session to create a list of concepts for an issue-based conference in a region of Québec to be held during the fiscal year. Support the planning & execution of such a conference
- Create a 1-pager to outline the structure, goals and activities of Local Youth Committees. Recruit for Local Committees, and provide training on budget management & activity development
- Offer the opportunity to volunteer Committee members to draft blog posts for publication on the new Regional Outreach tab.
- Manage a budget to create local activities, hold meetings, incentivise work tasks, attend government meetings, etc.

How the Committee's work relates to Y4Y's mandate: One element of Y4Y's mandate is to create a network of active, engaged English-speaking youth across the province. The ROC endeavours to connect youth across distance, and to support them in making their voices heard on issues affecting them and their peers in any given region of the province, through Y4Y's projects and activities.
