Set to take place on March 15, 2024, with youth from diverse backgrounds and varied life experiences on each panel, Y4Y promises to foster insightful discussions, which are anticipated to deepen an understanding of the aspirations of Québec youth for the future.

The event will feature an illuminating synopsis of Y4Y's research on English-speaking youth community, titled "Who we are, In Numbers and Nuances," along with lightning talks from organisations dedicated to youth leadership, including Elections Canada, the Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages, Apathy is Boring, and the Institut du Nouveau Monde.
